# 2011 Sierra Avalanche Ski-Orienteering Championships

- **7 days of competition over 9 days**
  - Bear Valley 1/30
  - Bear Valley 1/31
  - Rest/travel day 2/1
  - Tahoe Donner 2/2
  - Northstar 2/3
  - Rest day 2/4
  - Royal Gorge 2/5
  - Tahoe XC 2/6
  - Auburn Ski Club (Motala) 2/7
- **5 courses at each event**
  - White (beginner—on beginner trails)
  - Orange (intermediate—on intermediate trails)
  - Green (advanced—on any trails)
  - Red (advanced—anything goes)
  - Blue (advanced—anything goes and more)
- **2 new maps**
  - Royal Gorge (Greg Walker, GPS verified trails)
  - Bear Valley (Neil Hunt, GPS verified trails)
- **Electronic punching at all events** (as always)
- **Sierra scoring and medals to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> placers** in fully competitive classes
  - Finish one event and you're in the championship. Finish more to improve your score.
  - Winner gets 1000 points, others get points in proportion of their time compared to the winner's time.
  - Volunteer credits for those who work an entire event (100% of best score for fist day)
  - Absence credits for those who cannot attend all of the event (90% of average score)
- **Housing discounts** (for some great locations) available for volunteers
